All candidates must immediately return their academic dress at the end of the function. Any unreturned academic dress shall attract a penalty fee of **K5,000** for the first day of delay and **K2,000** for each subsequent day of delay payable before the release of the certificate.

Candidates who owe the College money shall not be allowed to graduate. Candidates who require photography services shall be informed about the details of accredited photographers during rehearsals. Candidates should contact their respective Colleges for invitation cards of their guardians.
